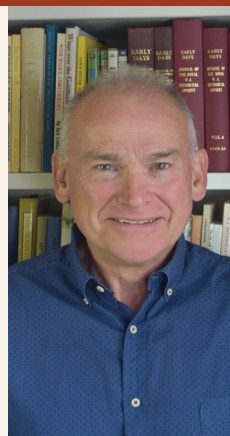

Historian, author and broadcaster, formerly the executive director of Heritage Perth, is now President of the Royal Western Australian Historical Society.
