Salute Their Service is a multi-media project that recounts the lives of local ANZAC heroes from the Shire of Dardanup, who lived in the area during the late 1800's to early 1900's.

Local historians and polemologists, Danny Harris, Jeff Peirce and Darren Foster, recall the stories of six ANZAC heroes, sharing personal anecdotes, heirlooms, and even personal memories in this short film. A partnership between the Shire of Dardanup, Lomax Media and the Department of Veteran Affairs, the film dives into the lives of William and Joseph Harris, Mervyn and James Ross, John George Foster, and Elma Mary Linklater to uncover their sacrifice, achievements, and struggles.

We hope that by sharing their stories, that their sacrifices are never forgotten, and their achievements are recognised as an integral testimony to the Dardanup community.

We trust this message encourages everyone to respect, reflect and remember all those that served in World War 1.
